Confirmation

Keeping with the policies of the Diocese of Parramatta the Parish's Sacramental Programme is a parish based, family centred, school supported programme. This means the programme is run through the parish and is not conducted by the schools.

Children baptised in an Eastern Catholic Rite, such as the Maronite or Melkite Rites, received confirmation at baptism. They are welcome to participate in the Sacramental Programme as a form of catechesis but cannot be 're-confirmed'. If they attend the Confirmation Mass, they can receive a blessing. Baptised Catholics who have celebrated the sacraments of Penance (Reconciliation) and Eucharist are eligible to prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Enrolment forms for Confirmation can be collected from the Parish Church while attending Mass during the period 16-17 June – 28-29 July 2018.

Japanese Host Visit

This year Catherine McAuley will be hosting a student's group from Japan. There are 25 girls coming, but at this stage only 15 host families have been arranged and so the invitation has been extended to Mother Teresa families. They are in need of 10 more families as hosts. Two Japanese students per family would also be possible.

Host families would be expected to:

- Pickup on the first day (23 July) at 4:30pm at Catherine McAuley
- Daily transfer to/from school (or commute to/from school with your students)
- 12 nights accommodation with 3 meals a day
- 1 single bed (sharing a room with your students is fine, but not sharing a bed)
- Decent amount of conversation in English with Japanese students




SCHOOL HOLIDAY PROGRAMS AT MACQUARIE UNIVERSITY - mq.edu.au/about/holidays
